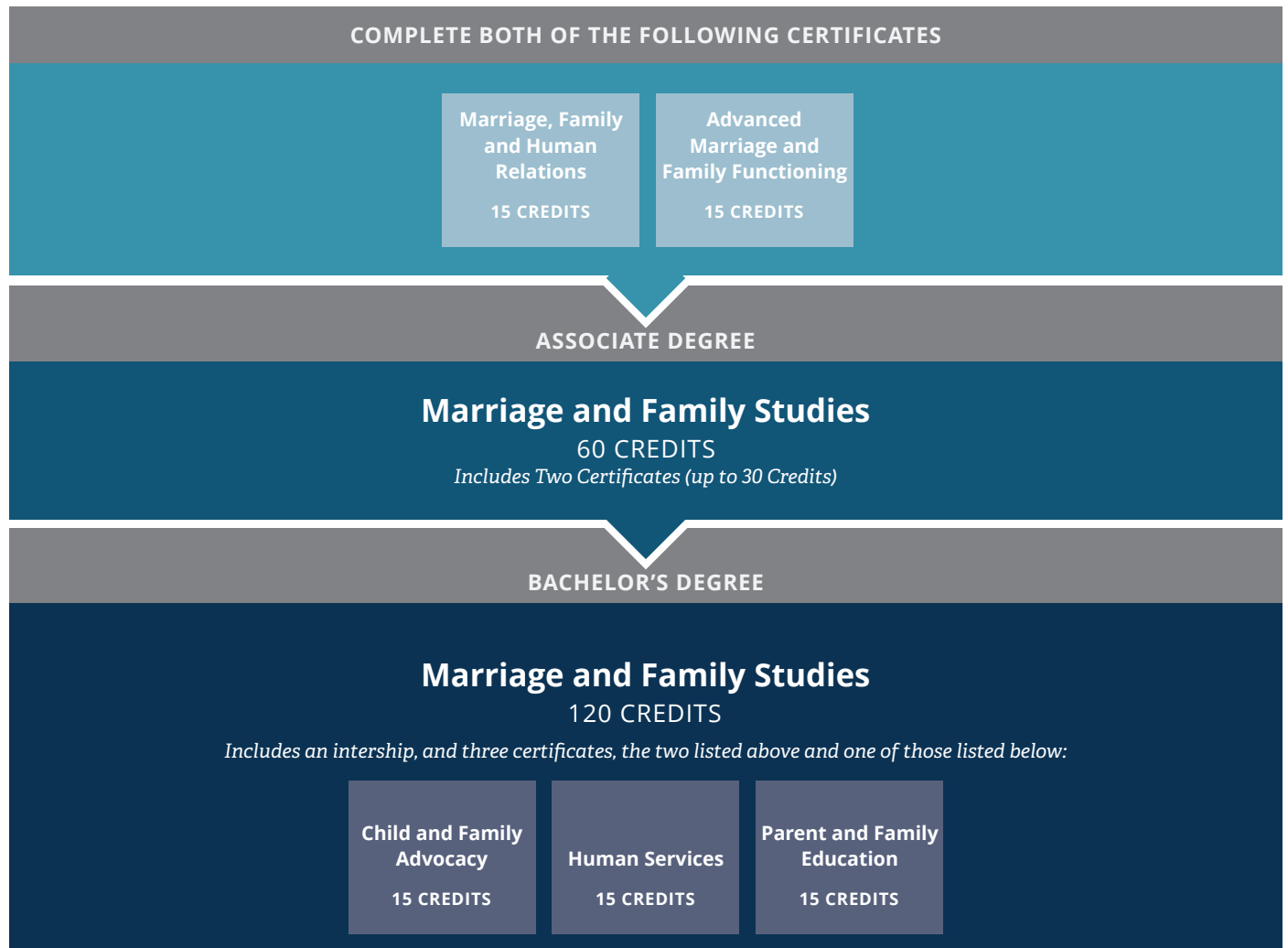


Marriage and Family Studies
